TEN YEARS OF COTTON.—It appears that the total quantity of cotton imported into the United Kingdom in 1856 was 1,023,886,004 lb.; in 1857, 963,318,896 lb.; in 1858, 1,094,342,176 lb.; in 1859, 1,225,989,072 lb.; in 1860, 1,390,938,752 lb.; in 1861, 1,256,984,736 lb.; in 1862, 523,973,296 lb.; in 1863, 669,583,264 lb.; in 1864, 893,304,720 lb.; and in 1865, 877,978,288 lb. In 1859 cotton averaged 6.76d. per lb.; in 1860, 7.17d. per lb.; in 1861, 7.39d. per lb.; in 1862, 14.24d. per lb.; in 1863, 21.97d. per lb.; in 1864, 21.01d. per lb.; and in 1865, 16.20d. per lb.
