POPULATION OF THE UNITED KINGDOM.

By the last Census, taken on April 3, 1871, it was ascertained that the number of persons living at midnight on the 2nd of the same month was as follows:—England and Wales, 22,704,108; Scotland, 3,358,613; and Ireland, 5,402,759. The Isle of Man contained a population of 59,567; Channel Islands, 90,563; and the Army and Navy, and merchant seamen abroad, numbered 267,188, giving a total of 31,817,108, against 29,374,384 in 1861—an increase of 2,442,724. During the ten years the population of Ireland decreased 396,208, and the Channel Islands 415; while the increase in England and Wales was 2,637,884; in Scotland, 296,319; and in the Isle of Man, 1898. The population of London, within the limits of the Metropolitan Local Management Act, has increased from 2,808,862 in 1861, to 3,264,530 in 1871; while in the city of London proper the number of residents has decreased from 112,063 to 74,732. The number of persons included within the limits of the London School Board District was 3,265,005.
