There is peril here, as in the haunts of meaner insects, of worms, grubs, and caterpillars, amid the leaves of plants or burrowing in the soil of the field. All brute creatures, or nearly all, seem to live in a state of war upon each other; yet we doubt not that the sum total of animal pleasure is thereby augmented. Perhaps, after all, it is not such a terrible fate to be eaten. The worm, in any case, will have its revenge upon the bodies of the most highly organised races after death, without excepting imperial Man.
