THE QUEEN.—Victoria, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, &c., Queen, Defender of the Faith. Her Majesty was born at Kensington Palace, May 24, 1819; succeeded to the throne June, 20, 1837, on the death of her uncle, King William IV; was crowned June 28, 1838; and married, Feb. 10, 1840, to his Royal Highness Prince Albert.
