The collection includes both realistic representations of flowers (generally with captions to identify them) and beautiful bouquet assortments that were used as page decorations, full-page illustrations, poetry frames and more. It also includes images of plants, fruits, leaves, seeds, mushrooms and more.

These images have been painstakingly edited to restore them as closely as possible to their original condition. The majority of these images are presented at 600 dpi, and, of course, at their full, original size. They are ideal for framing, art projects, publication, crafting and scrapbooking, classroom use and more. Enjoy!
